



Student Data Achievement 2026

The Bachelor of Interior Design is a four-year undergraduate program. The program typically takes a full-time student enrolled in 12–13 credits per term, approximately 10 terms to complete the program. The program's unique structure, with four intakes per year, allows students to complete their studies in 10 terms, or in as little as 2.5 years, provided they do not take study breaks and successfully complete all required courses.

The following data was collected using institutional records and an alumni survey that was administered 6 months after graduation. 63 out of 126 alumni responded to the survey.

Student Attrition and Retention

62% of the students admitted in 2025 returned in 2026, putting attrition at 38%.

Graduation Rates

Of the students graduating in 2025, 50% completed in 4 years or less, 27% completed in 5 years and 23% completed the program in 5 years or more.

Acceptance into Graduate Programs

Two of the students who graduated in 2025 applied for graduate school and were accepted.

Job Placement Rates

67% of the students who graduated in 2025 and who answered the survey are employed in interior design or related profession.
