INDIGENOUS STUDENT TUITION BURSARY

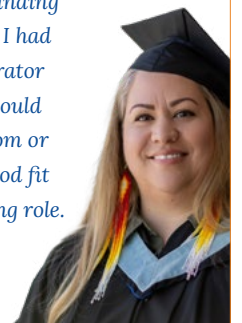
Launched on National Indigenous Peoples Day, Yorkville University's Indigenous Student Tuition Bursary provides a 25% tuition bursary* for all Indigenous students in Canada.

Eligible students must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents and provide one form of documentation supporting Indigenous ancestry. Refer to the application form for acceptable documents.

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What brought me to Yorkville University was my interest in finding ways to further Truth and Reconciliation through leadership.
